## Headteacher's Message

Dear Parents/Carers,

The children have now finished their first week of Maths sets and full class English and Topic timetables. Hopefully you have been able to make sure **PE kits** are in school, if not please make sure all children have the necessary kit next week.

Next week, I will be submitting an application to the Department for Education to form a **Multi Academy Trust** with **Dudley Wood, Kates Hill and Sledmere Primary Schools**. If this application is accepted then a full process of consultation will begin in the next few months. This application has the unanimous backing of the School Governors (including our 5 Parent Governors). We have been working closely with these schools (and Nethererton Park Nursery School, who are currently not yet permitted to form an Academy) for many years and this move is the next logical step for our collaboration and should greatly benefit all of our pupils.

I am sorry that the **Pupil Planners** have not yet been sent home, they were ordered over 8 weeks ago and we have only had them delivered today (and still not quite all) They will be sent home and used robustly from next week. Please accept our apologies in the delay.

You should by now have received your child's first **homework** of the term, please remember that pupils will need to return it to their teachers on **Wednesdays** otherwise they will need to do it at lunch or in Golden Time. If your child encounters difficulty with the homework then please speak to their teacher asap.

On Monday next week I will be sending out an update regarding '**Leave of Absence**' requests during term time. It is very important that all parents read this, for many parents it may contain some welcome news!

I have received a few complaints recently regarding the use of **bad language** by adults on and around the school grounds. Please support us in ensuring our pupils and our wider school community are treated with respect and not forced to listen to inappropriate language. 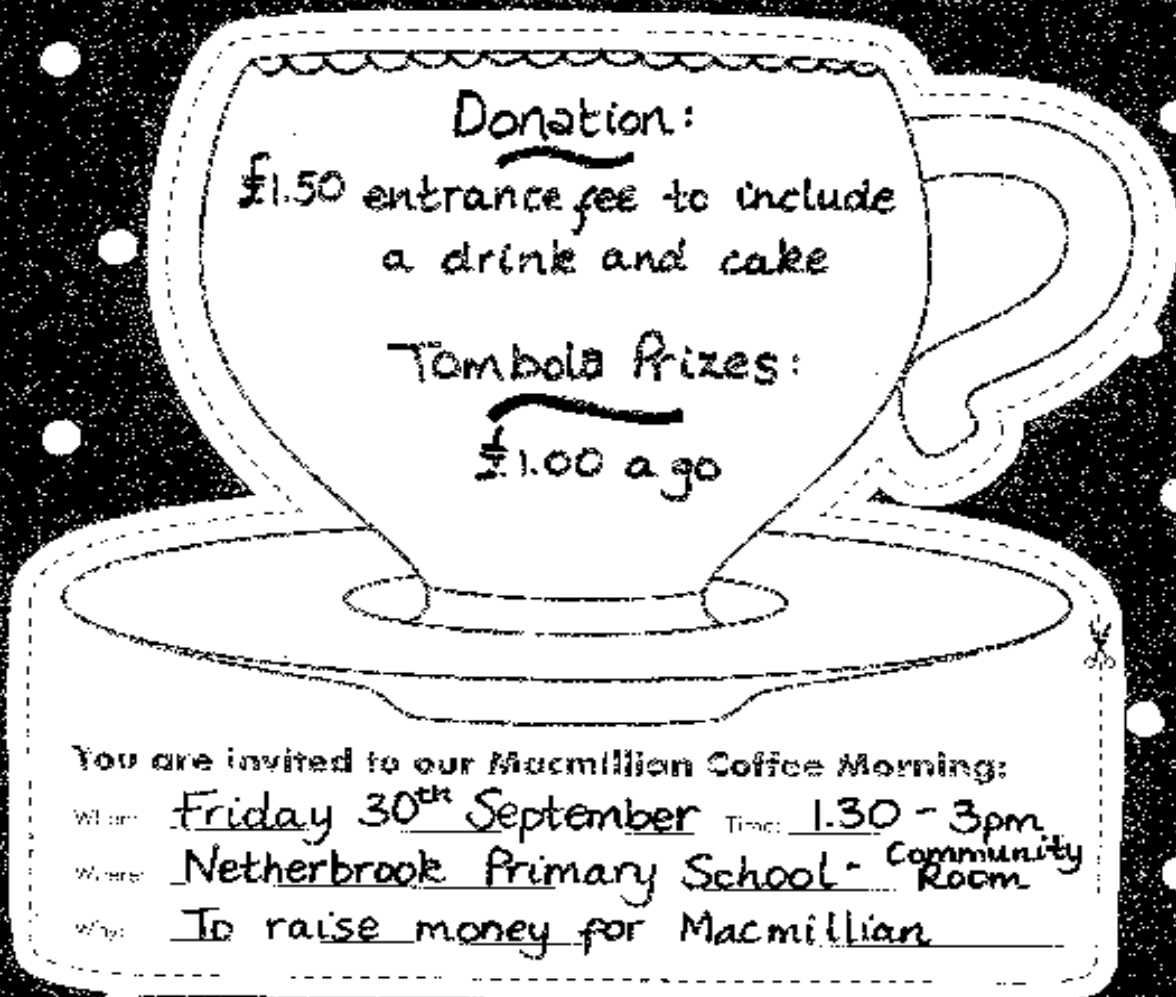
