Headteacher's Message

Dear Parents/Carers,

We are fast approaching the end of the school year, so here are a few reminders and updates.

Next Wednesday and Thursday evening sees the KS2 production of 'What a Knight'. The start time is 7.00pm prompt and the doors will open at 6.40pm. If your child is taking part please ensure they are back at school at 6.15pm for make-up and costume fitting etc. As I said last week, we really need to make the experience as good as possible for pupils and the audience so please try to keep noise to a minimum.

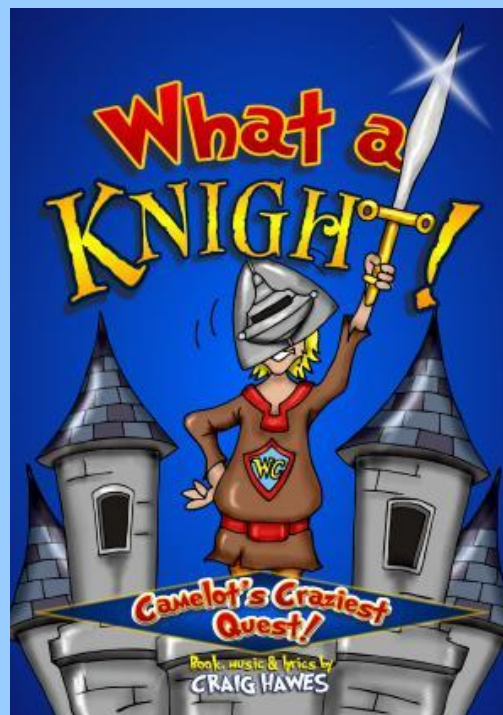
Please remember that **children under 5 years should not be brought to the shows**. This is due to the heat, time, length of the show and the noise created, this includes babes in arms. I'm sorry if this is inconvenient but we must put the pupils' performing first. Please contact the office if this is a problem. An extremely limited number of seats for our **Dress Rehearsal** on Tuesday 11th July can be made available for parents who may not be able to come due to childcare issues etc. These places will still require a ticket and are strictly first come first served.

Reports will be coming home on Friday 14th July and **Open Day** is the following week on Monday 17th July. 1.35pm – 3.00pm and then 3.30pm – 5.30pm. NB: Year 5 Open Day is only after school due to a school trip.

From September we will be working to improve our health and fitness and combat the ever growing litter problem here at Netherbrook. We will be operating a new **Healthy Breaktime Policy** in line with Dudley LA Policy and most other primary schools. I will write in depth about this next week but in simple terms from September; **no crisps, chocolate or sweets** will be permitted as break time snacks. Fruit and vegetables (i.e. carrot sticks etc) and water will be the only snacks children can bring in. Healthy snacks can still be purchased and eaten in the dining hall, such as toast. Additionally, at lunchtime pupils will only be permitted to have (in addition to sandwiches and fruit etc) **snack size chocolate bars** (E.g. Penguin/Club/Blue Ribband etc) and 25g (standard size) bags of crisps. We will also be conducting the **Daily Mile and 2 hours of PE** each week. I will also be exploring using Sport Premium money to purchase **child size exercise equipment** (Similar to those often seen in local parks) for both playgrounds to keep pupils active. If pupils are sent in with items that are no longer permitted they will not be allowed to eat them and will be returned unopened to parents at the end of the day. Thank you, in advance, for your support in this drive to improve the health of our pupils.
