Headteacher's Message

Dear Parents/Carers,

What an amazing week it has been. The Key Stage 2 Production of 'What a Knight' was absolutely fantastic. All of the children involved deserved their huge rounds of applause. They have learned lots of songs, hundreds of lines and were just brilliant. I am so proud of them all. I had many comments after the shows from people saying it's the best stage play they have ever seen! A big thank you also needs to go to the staff involved in helping, there are too many to mention them all but as usual Mrs Barfoot and Mrs Frost have done a superb job of getting the play ready on time.

We want more you might shout...well you won't have to wait for long. Next school year (2017-18) we will be trialling a move of the **KS2 Production to Christmas** instead. The end of year is such a busy time for Year 6 it seems to make sense. So, next year the Lower School will do the summer performance and Upper School will do the main Christmas Production. Early Years will continue with the Nativity.

Today you will be receiving your child's **School Report** for this year so please have a good read and come in to look at your child's books and meet their teacher at Monday's Open Day/Evening. 
