Dear Parents and Carers,

Next week is our Autumn Parents Evening. If you haven't already downloaded the SchoolLife app to enable you to select an appointment slot to meet your child's teacher then please do this ASAP. If you have any problems or need your log on details, please stop in and ask at the school office. Please remember that appointment slots are for ten minutes only. Teachers may need to ask you to come back and talk on another occasion if meetings go on beyond this time as it is unfair on parents attending later time slots.

Next week is also the Early Years Learning Together Day so I hope that many of you will be able to attend this event. Details will have been sent out to parents of pupils in the EYFS already.

Can I please remind all parents to make sure that if you choose to take your child on holiday in term time that you complete the leave of absence request forms well before the absence begins. We have experienced various issues over the last 10 weeks such as children saying that they have been on holiday when parents have said that they are poorly (we do not want the children to feel anxious about what they should or shouldn't say), photos of holidays appearing on Facebook which the school has become aware of, the school getting the international dialling tone when connecting to parents' mobile phones and other families informing us that people have gone on holiday when we conduct an attendance check home visit. I understand that nobody wants to receive the EIS fine that may accompany a holiday. However, these absences are not permitted by the Government and as a school we are required to follow this directive – if you choose to take a holiday you should do so knowing and accepting the potential consequences. Positive and trusting relationships between home and school are vital if we are to achieve the best for our pupils. So please support us by following our agreed procedures for leaves of absence.
