

## Netherbrook Primary School

### Progress Measures 2018

The progress measures are a type of value added measure, which means that pupils' KS2 results are compared to the actual achievements of other pupils nationally with similar prior attainment.

Progress scores are centred around **0**, with most schools within the range of **-5 to +5**.

- A **score of 0** means pupils on average do about **as well** at KS2 as those with similar prior attainment nationally.
- A **positive score** means pupils on average do **better** at KS2 as those with similar prior attainment nationally.
- A **negative score** means pupils on average do **worse** at KS2 as those with similar prior attainment nationally.

A negative score does not mean that pupils did not make any progress, rather it means they made less progress than other pupils nationally with similar starting points.

**Our average progress in Reading, Writing and Mathematics is above the Floor Standard.**
