

## **Sports Premium Funding**

Sports Premium is funding paid into the school from the government. The aim of this funding is to improve lifestyles and tackle obesity and other health related issues.

### **2014-15**

Netherbrook received £9500.00 Sports premium funding for 2014-15 financial year. This money has been spent on providing the following:

- Before School sporting activities for identified pupils.
- 'Fundamentals' active club for pupils in the EYFS.
- A comprehensive programme of lunchtime clubs including: football, basketball, netball and multi-sports. These clubs will take place three days per week for the next 12 months.
- A full programme of after school sports clubs fully funded by the school for targeted children. These will also take place on at least three days per week and are in addition to normal after school clubs provided by school staff.
- Additional 'Play' training has been booked for Lunchtime Supervisors for this year to further engage pupils in sports on the playground.
- A new 5-a-side football pitch will be created in the Key Stage 2 playground.
- Additional play equipment will be purchased for Key Stage 1 playground.

### **2015-16**

Netherbrook has received £5,714 for the next academic year. This money has been spent on providing the following:

- A comprehensive programme of lunchtime clubs including: football, basketball, netball and multi-sports. These clubs will take place three days per week for the next 12 months.
- A full programme of after school sports clubs fully funded by the school for targeted children. These will also take place on at least three days per week and are in addition to normal after school clubs provided by school staff.

Additional funding is often provided at a mid-year point. This money will be allocated to other provision to improve pupils' activity and high quality sports coaching across the school

The aim of this investment is to improve the lifestyles and overall health of the pupils in the school. We are currently redeveloping our dining hall and improving the quality of both the school dinners and the overall dining experience for pupils to further enhance the effects of this funding.
