PE and Sports Premium Statement

2016-2017

The government has provided Sports Premium funding for the academic year 2016-2017 to provide additional and sustainable improvements to PE and sport for the benefit of pupils and to encourage the development of healthy and active life styles.

Allocations for the academic year 2016 to 2017 are calculated using the number of pupils in Years 1 to 6 as recorded in January 2016 census. It will see money going directly to primary school head teachers to spend on improving the quality of sport and P.E.

Allocation of the funding 2016 – 2017

Netherbrook Primary School received in total £9774.00 for this academic year. This money has been spent on the following:

- A comprehensive programme of lunchtime clubs run by fully qualified sports coaches including: football, basketball, netball and tri-golf.
- A full programme of after school sports clubs partly subsidised by the school.
- Purchase of a new scheme of work for P.E and sport.
- Reduced cost access to all Sports Premium funded before and after school activities for children in receipt of Pupil Premium.
- Purchase of P.E /sports equipment/resources in school
