School Trips



English

This term in English, we will be focussing on our writing including sentence structure, grammar and punctuation in the context of a persuasive argument and a suspense story. We will also focus on developing our understanding of a non-chronological report.

Maths

Presently, we are busy preparing for our SATs exams. We are applying our knowledge and understanding to mathematical problems and refining different methods of calculation.

After SATs we will be solving mathematical problems based on real-life situations. These will include furnishing a room on a fixed budget and working out the overall cost of keeping a pet. This will involve the pupils working in groups so they can discuss the best methods to solve the problem and explain their reasoning.

We will also be working as a group to design a maths game for younger children in the school. The pupils will do research on games; complete questionnaires and survey their target group; plan and prepare the game then present it to the rest of the class for evaluation. This will be a 'Young Apprentice' type challenge.
