

Nursery Maths Activities

<p>Sorting Shapes. Draw large shape on paper or with chalk outside. Can you sort you bricks into the correct shape? Talk about the similarities and differences.</p>	<p>Road Shapes. Use tape to make shapes on the floor, can your child use a car to follow the shape outline. Talk about the differences between the shapes.</p>
<p>Make your own puzzle. You could use lollipop sticks selotaped together and draw a picture on them. Or cut up a picture that you've draw.</p>	<p>Draw around some of your child's toys. Can they match the toy to the outline?</p>
<p>Coin Sorting. Draw large circles, give your child a selection of coins and ask them to sort them into the different circles. Can they talk about the different coins?</p>	<p>How many socks long are you? Can you measure people in your house using socks? Who is the longest? Remember to lay the socks end to end.</p>
<p>Roll balls or cars, who's went the furthest? Can you think of ways of measuring the distance? Feet, hands etc?</p>	<p>Write numbers 1-10 on small pieces of paper. Use a hole punch/stickers/ draw the correct amount to match the number.</p>
<p>Play board games, counting the spots on the dice and moving the correct number of places.</p>	<p>Egg box game. Give each person an empty egg box. Put small objects in a box in the middle. Roll the dice and count out the correct number from the middle. The person to fill their egg box first wins.</p>
