

Are you worried about a child?

Do you have concerns about a child being abused, hurt or neglected?

If so you can speak directly to the Netherbrook Designated Safeguarding Lead: **Mr P Rawlings, Headteacher.**

or one of the 4 Deputy Designated Safeguarding Leads:

Mrs L Frost, Deputy Headteacher,

Mrs A Bowen, Attendance and Family Support Officer, Mrs C

Marshall, EYFS Assistant Headteacher,

or Mrs S Daly, Learning Mentor.

Alternatively, you can call Dudley Children's Social Care:

During office hours call the children's services referral and advice service on **0300 555 0050** (9:00am – 5:00pm Monday - Friday).

Out of office hours contact the Emergency Duty Team on **0300 555 8574** or in an emergency call **999**.

If you contact Dudley Safeguarding, you will speak to a professional who will listen to your concerns. They may take a few details and might need to contact you again but your concern will be dealt with quickly and appropriately.

You do not need to provide your name or give contact details if you do not wish to do so. Anonymous calls will not be ignored.
